



P: The Holy Gospel according to St. John, the third chapter.



going to him." John answered, "A person cannot receive even one thing unless it is given him from heaven."

THE NICENE CREED








WORDS OF OUR LORD

NOTES FROM PASTOR GALLIGAR

My Generous Heart: Every Good Gift – Jesus' cousin, John, the Baptizer said to his disciples, "A person cannot receive even one thing unless it is given him from heaven." Not one thing we have received came to us apart from the Father. James, the half-brother of Jesus, wrote a letter to the churches which stands near the end of our New Testament. While Jesus lived, James had trouble believing Him, as did many in that day. But following Jesus' death, James became a prominent leader in the Church. In James' letter he shares these words, "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights..." We often think of the "things" we have in this life as stuff we have earned, or bought, or paid for ourselves. James makes it clear that ALL we have is from our Father.

- ⊕ How can we do better when it comes to regarding our "stuff", as gifts from our Father?
- Recognizing that He has given us these gifts in order to advance the kingdom, where do we look first for ways in which to accomplish His work?

WELCOME TO THOSE WITH YOUNG CHILDREN: 😊 😊

We are so happy that you are here today! At Faith, we want you to feel at home.

- First, please relax and enjoy your time here. Jesus knows that children tend to wiggle and squawk a bit, so please don't feel embarrassed by it. Your children are welcome here!
- To make it a bit easier on your family, please dare to sit toward the front where your children can see all that is happening near the altar, note the colors, hear the music, watch the pastor, see

the candles, pay attention to the letters and images on the altar, pulpit and font, and embrace the action at the altar. What Jesus does here promises to engage them.

- As we go, softly explain the liturgy to your children, encouraging them to chime in on their parts; Amen! Lord, have mercy! Our Father...! I believe...! All of that belongs to them, too!
- Be sure to sing and say and pray your parts too as you stand and sit. The kids learn by following our example.
- If you or your child must leave, please hurry back. We want your children here so much that we hope the quiet room will only have to be used on special occasions. Like Jesus, we want your kids in worship, not out.
- If you need a little help, just let us know. There are lots of folks who would love to lend you a hand.

Please know that while you are caring for your children, the rest of us will be rejoicing in Jesus' words, "Let the little children come to Me and do not hinder them, for the Kingdom of God belongs to such as these." (Luke 18:16) We know that you are a gift to the church, so we will do our best to welcome, smile, encourage, help, and bless you all.
