Jeremiah 26:8–15

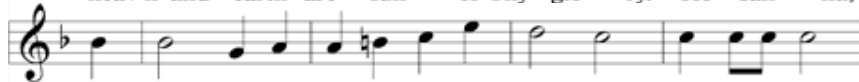

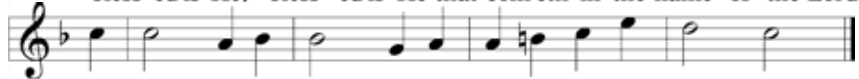


